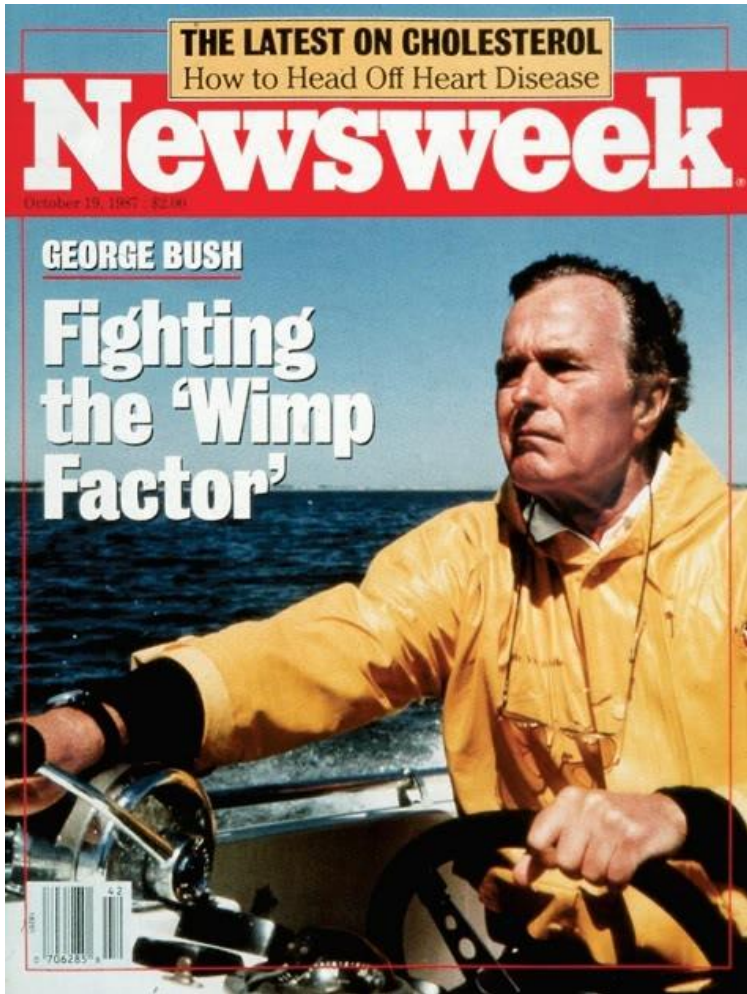

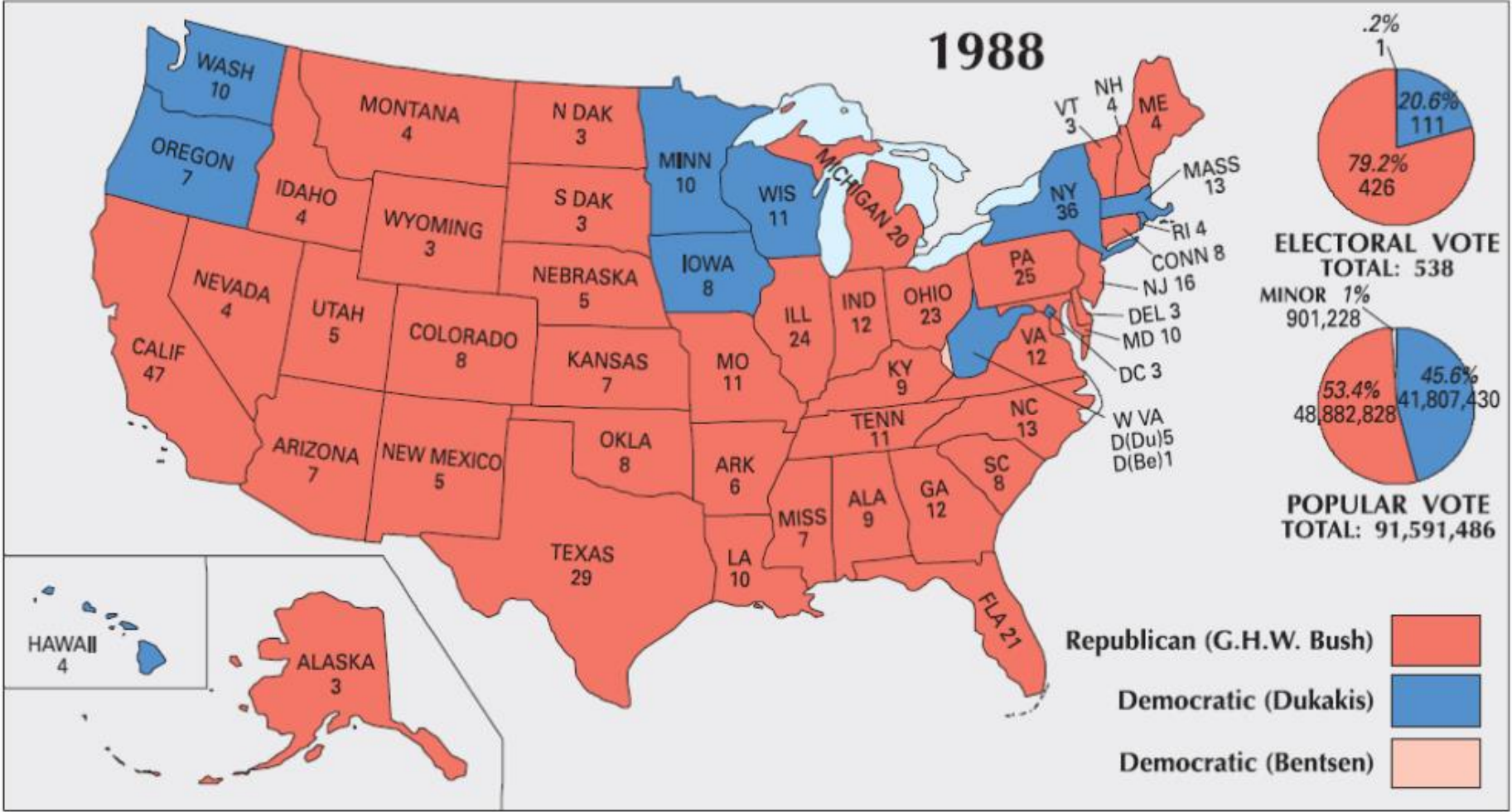

- USSR-aligned until 1960 (Year) Communist Rule Ended





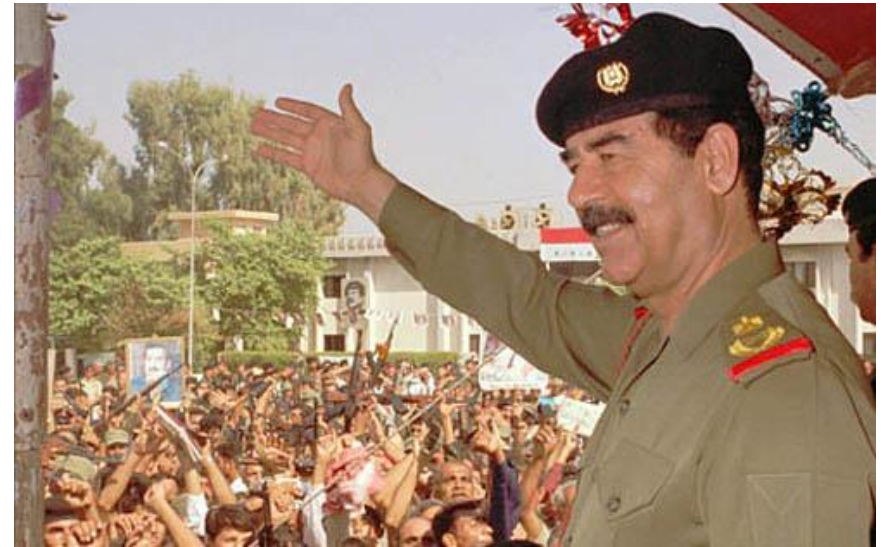

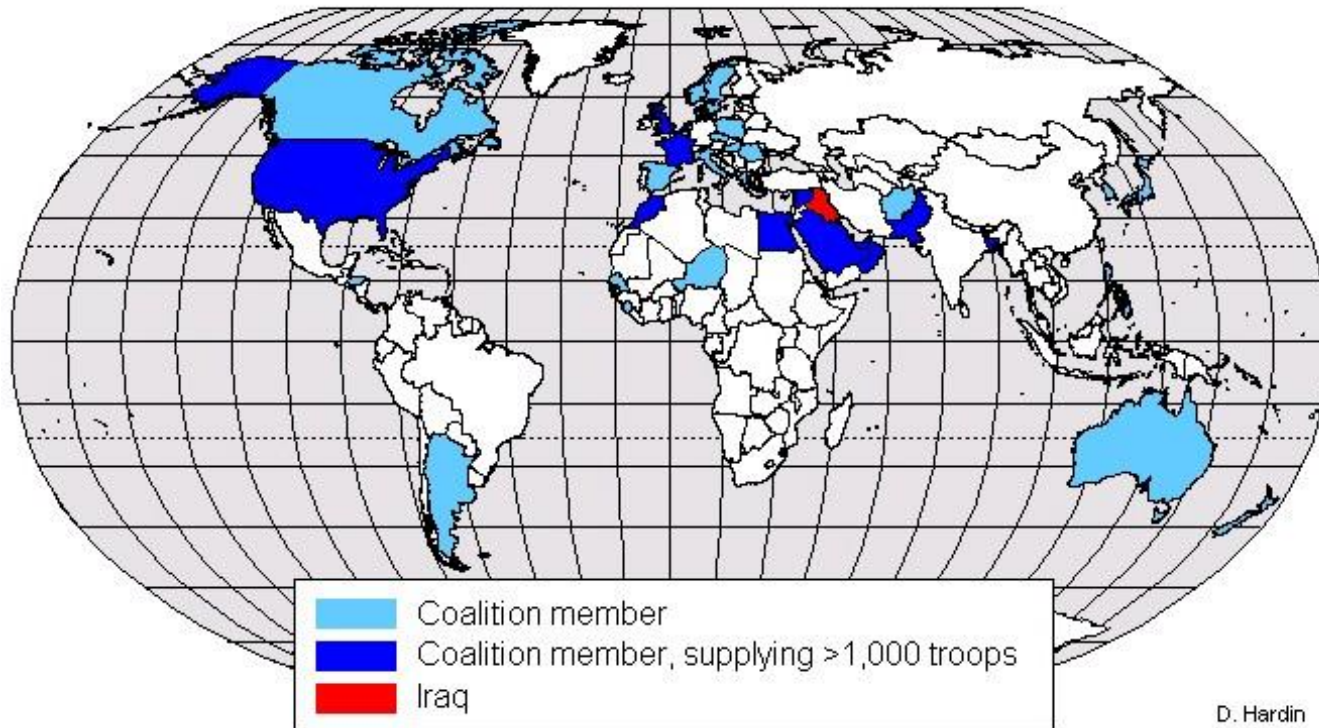
Iraq Invades Kuwait

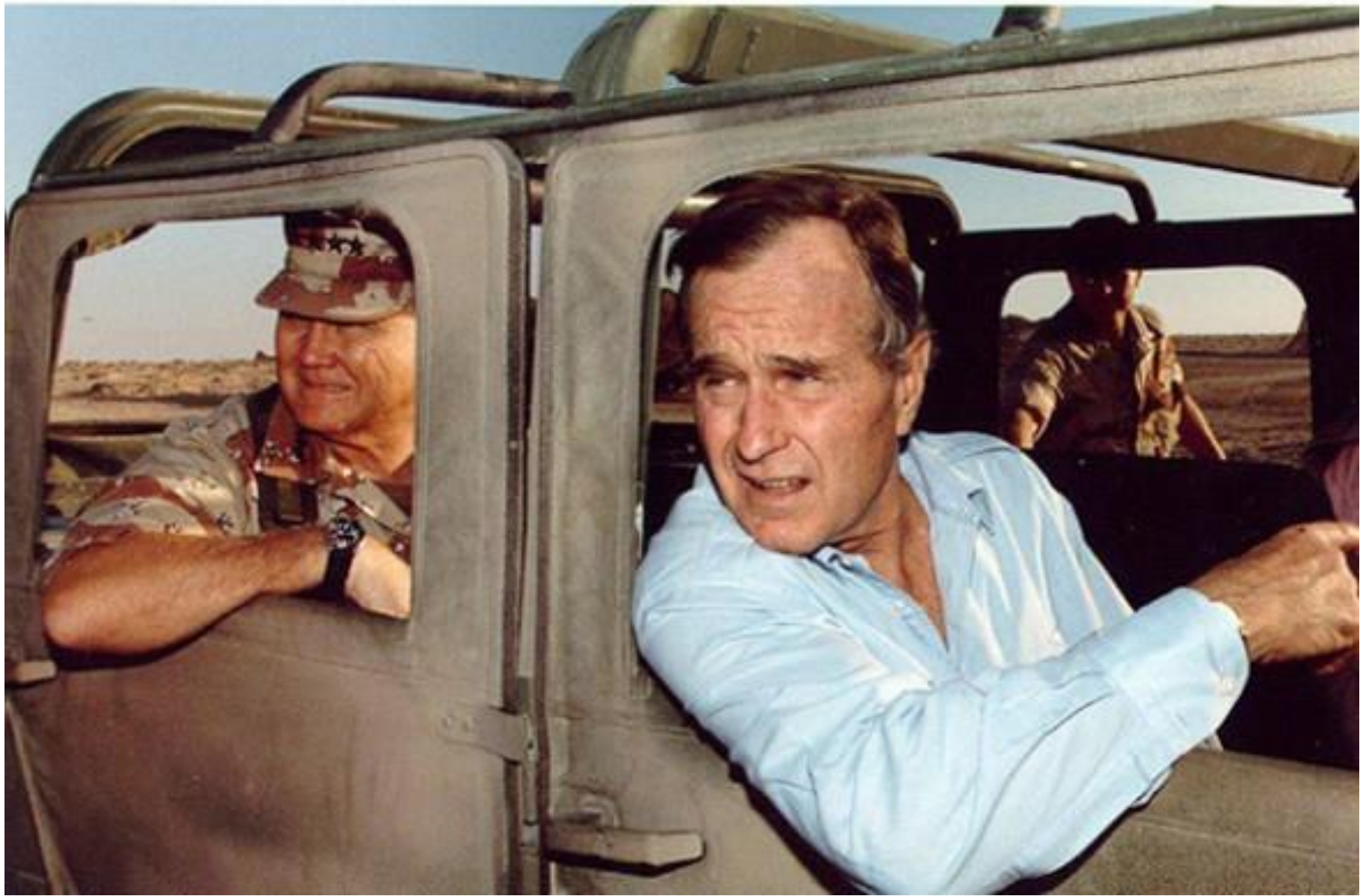
Operation Desert Storm 1991

- ▶ January, 1991

 - ▶ After a month of intense bombing, only a minimal ground assault was necessary to remove Iraq from Kuwait.



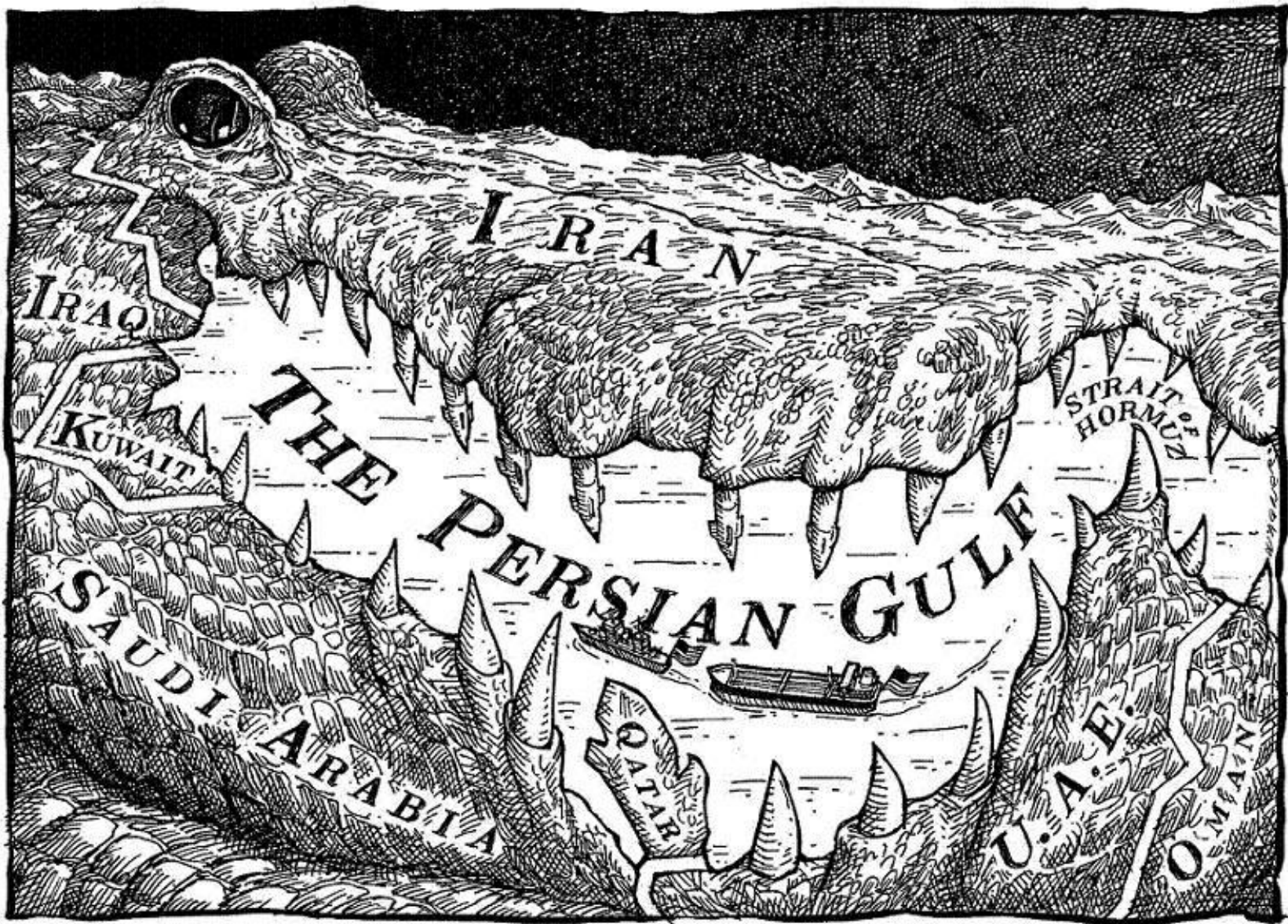


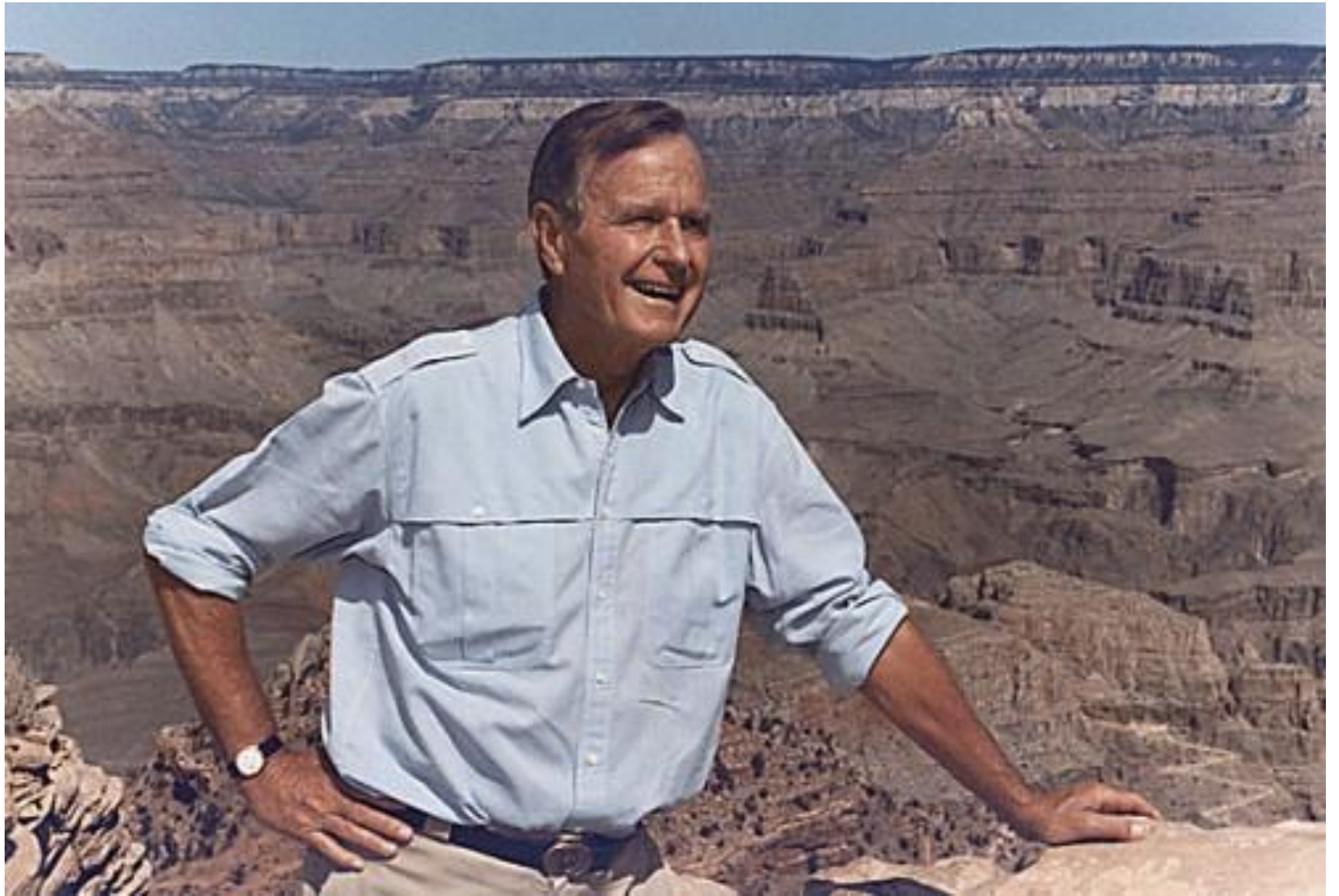






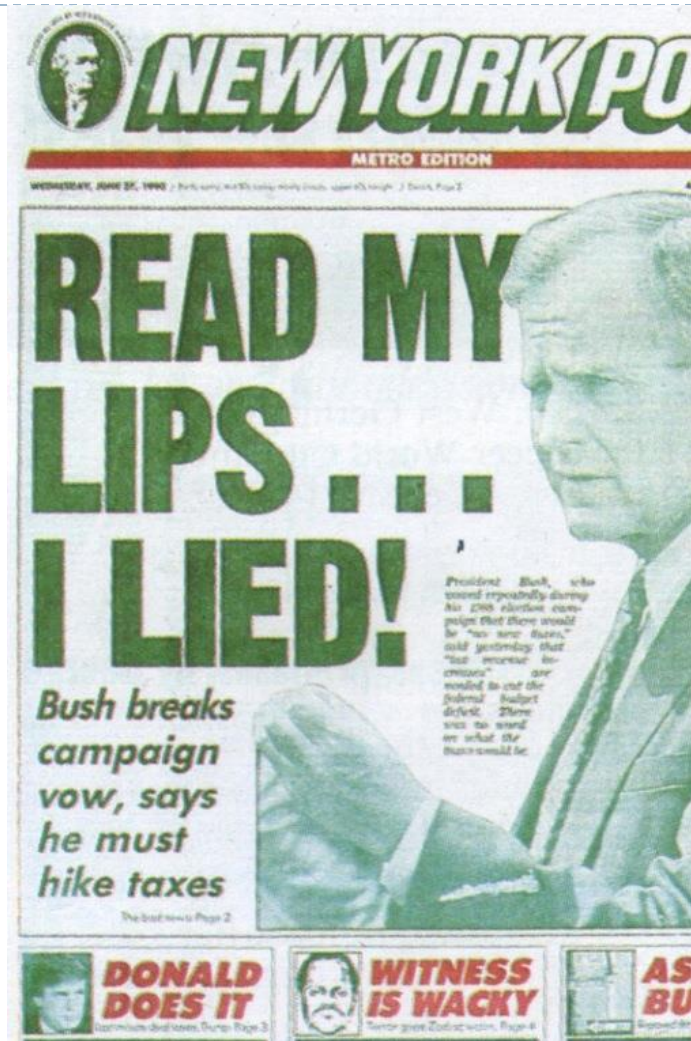






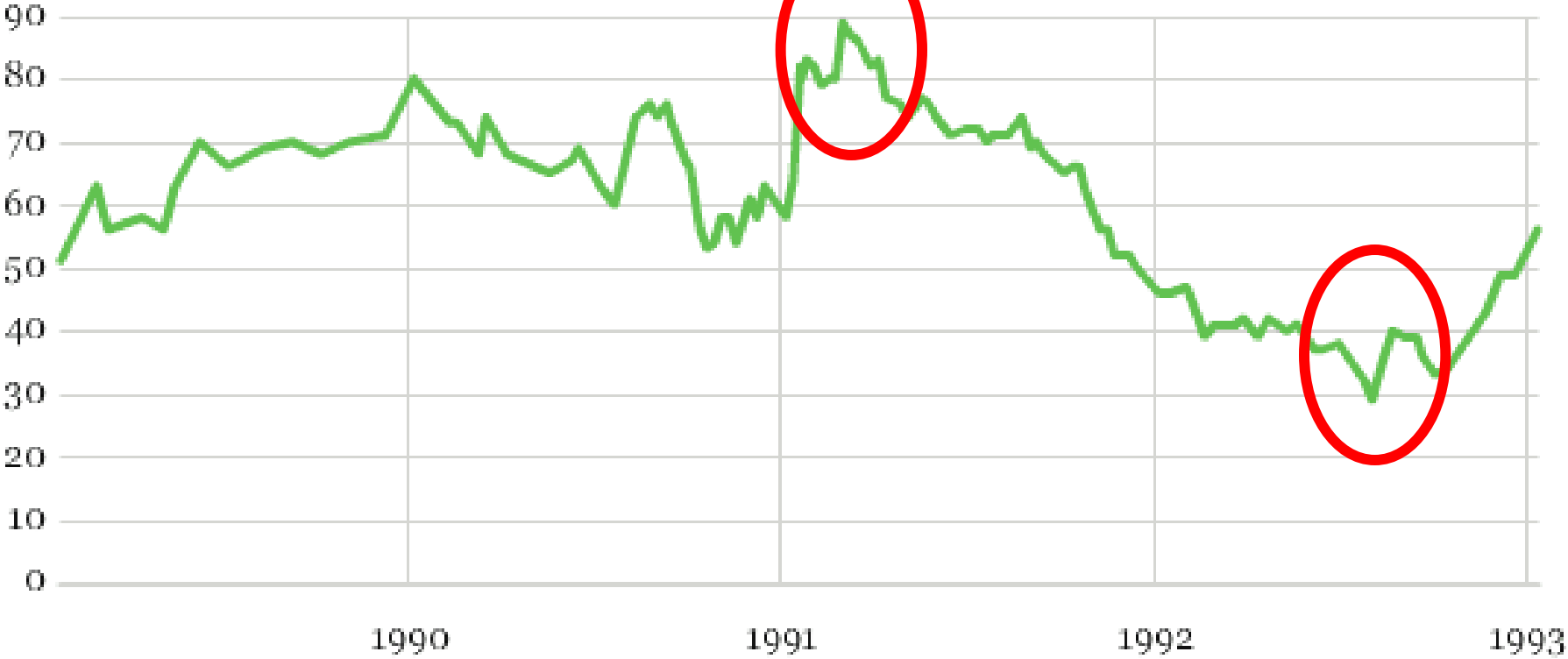
Economic Issues: Recession 1992

- ▶ George Bush's popularity rose to over 80%. However, within a year the massive deficits from the 80s caught up with the economy.
 - ▶ Recession hits
 - ▶ Bush's turns back on his "No New Taxes Pledge"
- ▶ By 1992, Bush's popularity was eroded by the faltering economy.
